## Birding the River Niger

*Mali is home to hundreds of bird species. On top of that there are the migrating birds, who spend some time in the country during their migration.*

The area around Ségou houses an impressive number of bird species. Especially around the River Niger, where you'll find the water birds as well.

Species in and around Ségou:

- cormorants
- African Jacana (= Lily-trotter)
- King fishers
- Koulikoro fire finch (only to be seen in Mali)
- herons and egrets
- weavers
- eagles
- parakeets
- Senegal Coucal
- owls
- Abyssinian roller
- hornbills

and many more!

Set out on a boat trip with an ornithologist and go birding the River Niger.
