



## Discover Mali's art Farako pottery village

*At about 14 kilometres from Ségou is where the riverside village of Farako is situated. Besides pottery, bogolan is being made in the village.*

The village of Farako - located on the other riverbank - is sometimes referred to as 'the other pottery village'. All kinds of pottery, varying from traditional water jugs to modern vases are being made by hand. Every woman has her own specialty.

Usually on Saturday afternoon pots are being baked in huge fires.

On Mondays you'll find the women of Farako at Ségou's pottery market to sell their products.

When traveling by boat to Farako there's a chance to spot hippos en route.
