River Niger camping trip with Farako & Segoukoro

On this camping trip we take you out on the River Niger by pinasse to explore the surroundings of Ségou and camp on an isle.

From Ségou the journey goes upstream. The quiet pace of traveling by boat guarantees a relaxing weekend. Lunch is being served on the way to Farako. The pottery village is located on the other riverbank. All kinds of pottery, varying from traditional water jugs to modern vases are being made by hand. Every woman has her own specialty. Usually on Saturday afternoons pots are being baked in huge fires.

After the village visit the boat trip continues and camp will be made on an isle.

Enjoy a relaxing Sunday morning with breakfast on the camp site. The nearby village of Kamalé is visited before starting the journey back towards Ségou. There's a chance to see hippos en route. Visit the village of Segoukoro - the capital of the former Bambara Kingdom.

Arrival at the Ségou river quay is foreseen for 2pm. Bird lovers have the chance to spot some of Mali's beautiful feathered inhabitants.
