## sail the Niger river to visit Kalabougou pottery village

*On this river trip we take you to the pottery village Kalabougou located on the Niger river shore, about 8 kilometres from Ségou.*

The village of Kalabougou - located on the other riverbank - is home to the pottery women. All kinds of pottery, varying from traditional water jugs to modern vases are being made by hand. Every woman has her own specialty.

Usually during the weekend pots are being baked in huge fires. On Mondays you'll find the women of Kalabougou at Ségou's pottery market to sell their products.

A pleasant and relaxing boat trip of about an hour takes you to the village. Bird lovers have the chance to spot some of Mali's beautiful feathered inhabitants living in the vegetation on the river shores and isles.

Enjoy the sunset on the way back to Ségou when doing this trip in the afternoon.
