



Experience Mali sail the Niger river to Segoukoro

Set out on a trip by pinasse on the Niger river to visit the old village of Segoukoro, where part of the rich history of the region has been conserved.

The capital of the former Bambara Kingdom - as described in Maryse Condé's books *Ségou* - is Segoukoro.

The village, which is located at the Niger river bank at about 14 kilometers from Ségou, offers lots to see, including four mosques and the tomb of the first Bambara king.

Traditionally a visit to Segoukoro starts with meeting the village chief to pay the taxes. The village chief enjoys people's interest in his village and you're welcome to pose your questions.

Bird lovers have the chance to spot some of Mali's beautiful feathered inhabitants during the trip.

Enjoy the sunset on the way back to Ségou when doing this trip in the afternoon.
