



Experience Mali sail the Niger river Ségou - Mopti

The stretch from Ségou to Mopti - more than 400 kilometres by river - gives the opportunity to follow part of the journey made by explorer Mungo Park, who visited multiple villages along the way and spent several months in Sansanding.

A pleasant and interesting journey on a traditional wooden boat with 21st century comfort.

The Canal of Tio is equipped with a lock to ensure the safe passage between its two sides, bridging a difference in height of several meters.

Bozo, Fulani and Bambara are the most dominant population groups along this part of the river. You'll see the fishermen in their pirogues and the herders with their herds on the shores.

You visit their villages with lovely mud-built mosques and colorful markets. Nomadic Bozo settlements are to be seen on the isles and shores.

Birders will enjoy watching the birds, living in the vegetation on the shores.

The crew prepares the meals with the catch of the day and local products. The guide explains about the history of the Niger river, the country and the culture. Camp on the isles and shores with evenings under the star-spangled sky, sharing stories around the campfire. Enjoy quality time with friends and family.
