



Experience Mali Ségou's river quay

There's something special about life along the river quay. The flowing water makes for a quiet atmosphere in which daily life and chores go along with history.

Set out on a walk along Ségou's river quay with one of our guides to learn about the past & present of this part of Ségou.

The beautiful kaicedra trees - dating back to the colonial times - where planted to provide shadow. Stroll along historical landmarks like the Farabuloun tunnel, Archinard's statue and some colonial houses. In between daily life takes place. The river shore is the place where girls and women gather for dish washing and laundry.

Don't miss out on the pottery market. All pottery is made by the women from the nearby villages Kalabougou and Farako.

This walk can be combined with:

- a visit to bogolan workshop Soroblé
- a boat trip on the River Niger
