River Niger camping trip

Kalabougou, Bozo & hippos

On this camping trip we take you out on the River Niger by pinasse to explore some of the best spots in the surroundings of Ségou and to camp on an isle.

day 1

The trip starts with a visit to the village of Gueni, a fishing village on the other river bank to get an impression of life in the village. Lunch is being served en route for Kalabougou pottery village, where the pottery women are visited and with a bit of luck the huge weekly fires for the baking of the pots can be seen (on Saturday or Sunday only). Camp is being made on an isle in the Kalabougou surroundings.

day 2

Enjoy a relaxing morning with breakfast on the camp site. A nomadic Bozo settlement is visited in the morning before setting out on an upstream trip on the River Niger to search for hippos*. Enjoy lunch on the way back to Ségou. Arrival at the river quay is foreseen around 2pm. Bird lovers have the chance to spot some of Mali's beautiful feathered inhabitants.

** hippos tend to move from time to time; sightings cannot be guaranteed*
