## day-trip Abomey-vooodoo village

*Welcome to Abomey!  
Today we take you on a tour to the less-known sites in and around the town, which once was the capital of the Dahomey Kingdom.  
This trip includes a visit to a village, to learn more about the fascinating voodoo religion. All too often associated with dolls and needles, the religion is based on the white side of voodoo, in which magic is put to good use: to help people solve the challenges they are facing in their lives. By consulting the voodoo idols voodoo masters can suggest and perform the ceremonies needed to realign people with their ancestors and idol.*

Around 9am your guide picks you up from your hotel for the short drive to the archaeological museum. The museum provides an introduction to ancient skills used to work with metal. Continue to the royal palace for a visit. After lunch a short drive leads to a village, where voodoo is the main religion. The guide explains about the voodoo religion and a visit is made to a voodoo master, who will perform a voodoo ceremony for you. Transfer back to Abomey in the late afternoon, drop-off at the hotel expected around 6pm.
