Djougou & Taneka country



Djougou is initially not on most travellers list for a stop on the way up North. That is until they hear about its hidden gems and about nearby Taneka country!

The Taneka people is a population group, which has remained loyal to their ancient culture. The King and Spiritual Leader play an important role in everyday life of the community. They are the counsellors people turn to whenever needed.

08:30am pick-up from your accommodation by your guide for the road-trip to Taneka country. First destination is the cultural bank. The bank looks like a museum, yet none of the items on display belongs to them. They are pledges for microloans given to the Taneka owners of the cultural artefacts. Continue to a Taneka village, where courtesy visits are made to the King and the Spiritual Leader. They are more than happy to answer your questions about their culture and life. The visit equally provides an introduction into the Taneka culture and a view of everyday life of the people. Lunch is eaten in the village. Around 4pm the journey goes back to Djougou for a visit to a weaving workshop and a workshop where aluminium is recycled. Drop-off at your hotel in Djougou around 6pm.
