



# Experience Benin day-trip Pendjari Park

*Situated in the North of Benin Pendjari Park is often on travellers' shortlists and hardly needs an introduction.*

*Listed as a UNESCO natural heritage, the park is mentioned as the best national park in West Africa. The vast area is home to a variety of wildlife.*



An early morning wake-up call for your day-trip to Pendjari National Park.

Your driver/guide meets you at your hotel at 5:30am for the drive up North of about 140 ks. The aim is to arrive at the park gates, just before they open at 9am. The morning hours and late afternoon offer excellent changes to spot wildlife.

The park is home to elephants, buffalos, warthogs, multiple antelope species, topis, lions, hyenas, baboons, red monkeys, hippos, crocodiles and hundreds of bird species, including storks, kingfishers, ibis and hammerkops.

Game drives are made in the morning and late afternoon, including visits to several of the observation points in the park.

With a bit of luck one of the leopards will be spotted. Lunch can be eaten in one of the hotels in the park. Around 5pm departure from the park for the journey back to Natitingou.
