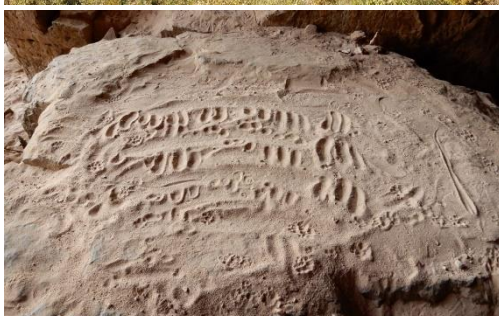
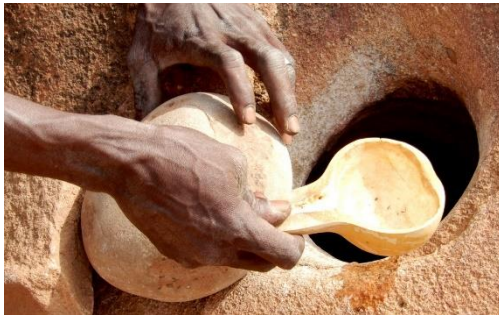




Discover Manding country Siby and surroundings

Welcome to Manding country, a place of history and a warm welcome in the Southwest of Mali. This day-trip is dedicated to exploring the village of Siby and its surroundings.



Bamako - Siby - Bamako

07:30am pick-up from the accommodation for the road-trip to Siby, where the local guide joins us. Our first visit is to Djéliba. From the village we hike up the mountain to see the ancient rock-drawings. A visit is made to Tabou's sacred well, before we are dropped-off in Kalasa. From here we climb the hill for a visit to the Arc of Kamadjan, where the guide shares stories about the history of the region. We visit the consultation cave, and eat our sandwich lunch under the arc with a magnificent view on the surroundings. After lunch we descend and transfer by car to Siby for a visit to the village and to the Fanfaba cave, where water leaks from the rocks. This source of pure water is where villagers and youngsters come to relax and to fill up their water bottles. In the late afternoon we travel back to Bamako, where we are dropped-off at our accommodation.
